### **Application Form**

ANZIC Governing Council are pleased to announce that they will be offering a maximum \$3K AUD/NZD travel bursaries to attend IODP Workshops in 2020. Support will be made available to successful Australian & New Zealand applicants approved to attend workshop by organisers. ANZIC will select applicants based on the basis of ANZIC Science Committee ranking of applications.

## **Application Procedure**

- Completed application form
- A letter of support from a Supervisor/In-line Manager

Payment will only be paid to institutions and upon awarding offer of acceptance, after the application process has closed.

#### **Terms & Conditions**

- 1. Successful applicants will need to provide a 2 page report and appropriate photo of themselves at the workshop.
- 2. Applicants will need to adhere to the IODP code of conduct and that of their own institution.
- 3. Travel bursary is limited *strictly to assisting flights* to and from Australia/New Zealand and for *registration to the workshop* only (not for accommodation, per diem, side/field trips, insurance, salary etc).
- 4. The travel bursary will be up to \$3K AUD for Australian Applicants and \$3K NZD for New Zealand Applicants.
- 5. Supervisor/In-line Manager must provide a letter of support indicating that they support attendance and that their institution will cover the applicant for other costs/insurance.
- 6. Funds may only be used for IODP workshop occurring in 2020 and can not be purchased for workshops in subsequent years.
